We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes.

You may request details of personal information which we hold about you. If you would like a copy of the information held on you, please contact us.

If you believe that any information we have about you is incorrect or incomplete, or you would like us to remove your information, please contact us as soon as possible. We will promptly correct any information found to be incorrect, or securely delete any information, as requested.

In the unlikely event that you believe your information has been misused, please contact us with details. We will seek to deal with your request without undue delay. Please note that we may keep a record of your communications to help us resolve any issues that you raise. We will, in accordance with reporting procedure, inform the Information Commissioner's Office as required.
